

# Winslow Regatta

The 2008 George Winslow Memorial Regatta was held on Saturday, July 26<sup>th</sup> in a 10-15 knot southerly breeze. John Bonds, the principal Race Officer, set up the start/finish line just south of Gould Island.

At 1200, John signaled the first windward-leeward course for the Shields class; "Zp" (Special Race Mark N.W. Dumplings). Zp was also the course for the second race with "Rp" to port for the third race. The average rhumbline course distance was 6 nm.
